## **Customer Input Notice**

The Village of Ludlow Electric Department (Ludlow) has submitted its 2022 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) to the Vermont Public Utility Commission (PUC) for review. The IRP represents Ludlow's plan for meeting the public's need for energy services safely, reliably and at the lowest present value life cycle cost, including environmental and economic costs. The plan includes an analysis of Ludlow's energy needs and supply resources; its planned improvements to its electrical system, including vegetation management; environmental impacts; and the costs associated with the plan. Utilities must file IRPs with the PUC and the Public Service Department at least every three years.
