# Manager's Report March 29, 2023

We were able to prepare February year to date financial reports. And now I will give you each a copy for review. A key item on the Income Statement is sales year to date over last year. The total revenue to date is 98k less that than the previous year resulting in a 72k loss year to date.

Update on the rate increase: 5.27% across the board rate increase was filed with the VT Public Utility Commission on March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Once we get approval from the PUC, rates will be applied to the services rendered after May 1<sup>st</sup> billed in June.

Update on security cameras. Cameras have been installed at the office and shop. Substation cameras will be installed when the weather permits as we need to run some cable underground.

The Light Department has requested a quote from Milton Cat for new 2023 Caterpillar 416 rubber tire backhoe. I will now present to all a copy of their quote. I will let Brett speak more about why the department should invest in the backhoe.

<u>OTHER BUSINESS:</u> Commissioner Brandt asked about concerns with GMP using Ludlow poles. Foreman Sanderson informed that GMP was installing new lines and poles to service their customers at the Southface location.
