Affordable Community Renewable Energy (ACRE) is a community solar program that's helping qualifying Vermonters lower monthly electric bills with steady bill credits. To apply, you will need a copy of your electric bill and information about your household income. Applications are open April 7 through August 31, 2026.

Support from the Vermont Public Service Department makes it free to participate.





ACRE Eligibility Requirements

ACRE is available exclusively to income-qualifying Vermonters who are residential customers of a participating electric utility.

There are two eligibility requirements:

1. You are a residential customer of one of the following electric utilities: Barton, Enosburg Falls, Hardwick, Jacksonville, Johnson, Ludlow, Lyndon, Morrisville, Northfield, Orleans, Swanton
2. You participate in one of the following benefit programs or have a household income at or below the level in the table.
 - 3SquaresVT
 - Essential Person
 - Fuel Assistance
 - Reach Up (Reach First, Reach Ahead, PSE)

If you do not participate in one of these programs, but your household income level is at or below the following level, you may still qualify.

Household of 1: \$2,413/month or \$28,953/year
Household of 2: \$3,260/month or \$39,128/year
Household of 3: \$4,109/month or \$49,303/year
Household of 4: \$4,957/month or \$59,478/year
Household of 5: \$5,805/month or \$69,660/year
